



## **Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd Vendor Obligations to the Modern Slavery Act of 2015**

Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd is committed to complying with all anti-slavery and human trafficking laws. Specifically, in 2016, Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd began implementing measures to comply with the recently enacted United Kingdom Modern Slavery Act of 2015. As part of the fulfillment of that commitment, Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd has outlined certain obligations of its vendors. Your business, and our relationship, is important to Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd. So, it is vital you and your organization understand these obligations.

### **Vendor's Obligations**

In connection with anti-slavery and human trafficking laws and Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd policy, Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd's expectations of you and your organisation when working for Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd are described below:

1. While working on behalf of Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd, or on behalf of any of Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd's affiliates, you will actively work to ensure that modern slavery, indentured servitude and human trafficking is not happening within your Supply Chains.

The prohibition of this type of activity extends to any party you may hire to act on Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd's behalf (when permitted by your contract).

2. Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd encourages you to publish an annual statement on your company website affirming your commitment to preventing modern slavery.
3. Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd encourages you to develop policies designed to prevent modern slavery and human trafficking within your organization and within those organizations that may be called upon to provide services on behalf of Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd.
4. Mechanical Engineering Ventures Ltd encourages you to create training aimed at educating your organization on modern slavery and human trafficking.
